**Final Results – October 10, 2006
Green Brook Country Club, North Caldwell**

The 2006 New Jersey State Golf Association Mens' and Ladies' Tournaments of Club Champions yielded two new winners at the par 71, 6618 yard (Men) and par 73, 5727 yard (Ladies) Green Brook Country Club in North Caldwell. The Mens' Championship, sponsored by Bollinger Insurance, was captured by Christopher Housen of Manasquan River Golf Club. Housen bested Mike Paduano of Howell Park Golf Course, Charles Roberts of Lake Mohawk Golf Club, and Stephen Shellock of Eagle Oaks Golf Club in a sudden-death playoff. Housen's one-over par effort of 72 (38-34) was enough to claim his first NJSGA Tournament of Champions victory. Two-time reigning Champion Jay Blumenfeld of Mountain Ridge Country Club finished in a tie four-way tie for fifth place with his three-over par 74 (37-37).

In the Ladies Championship, sponsored by Lincoln-Mercury, Annette Gordon of Beacon Hill Country Club shot a twelve over par 85 (39-46) to claim the 3rd Ladies Tournament of Club Champions title. Miki Melzer of the Golf Mission finished second (88); Sue Skowronski of Upper Montclair Country Club finished third with 91.
