MOUNT HOLLY, NEW JERSEY – Tom Greenwood of Old York C.C. at Chesterfield shot a one-over par 71 (35-36) to claim medalist honors in the first of three qualifying rounds for the 109th New Jersey State Golf Association Amateur Championship at the par 70, 6611 yard Burlington Country Club in Mount Holly. Greenwood leads fifteen players into the 72-hole, stroke play Championship proper which will be held at the Montclair Golf Club in Montclair June 8 – 10. Greenwood's impressive day also included a hole-in-one on the 148 yard, Par-3 fifth hole.
