Bataille, the two-time NJSGA Junior Champion and currently the Men's Golf Coach at Rutgers University, leads a total of twenty-five (25) golfers who have qualified for the 72 hole, stroke play championship at Montclair Golf Club June 8-10. The third and final qualifying round will be held this Wednesday at Apple Ridge Country Club in Mahwah which will complete the Championship field. Michael Deo of High Bridge Hills is the defending champion.
