89th Open Championship – Sectional Qualifying Round
Wednesday, June 17, 2009 – Greenacres Country Club

Professional Jeff Bonicky of Sea Oaks Country Club fired a one-over par 72 (34-38) to claim medalist honors in the second of four qualifying rounds for the 89th New Jersey State Golf Association Open Championship at the par 71, 6,447 yard Greenacres Country Club in Lawrenceville. Bonicky's effort leads a total of thirteen contestants into the Championship proper which will be held at the Rock Spring Club in West Orange July 14-16. Marc Issler of Woodlake Country Club was low amateur with his three-over par total of 74 (36-38).

The 54 hole stroke play Championship will be contested over three days (July 14-16); Mark McCormick of Suburban is the defending Champion.
