

**Results – Sectional Qualifying Round**  
**75<sup>th</sup> New Jersey State Golf Association Four Ball Championship**  
**Harkers Hollow Golf Club, Phillipsburg, New Jersey**

The Brooklake team of Robert Lobel and Mike Kukoff today combined to card a six-under par 64 (31-33) and claim medalist honors in the first of two qualifying rounds for the 75<sup>th</sup> New Jersey State Golf Association Four Ball Championship at the par 70, 6539 yard Harkers Hollow Golf Club in Phillipsburg. Lobel and Kukoff lead a total of fifteen teams into the Championship proper, which will be contested Tuesday through Thursday, August 21-23 at the Montclair Golf Club in Montclair.

The Four Ball Championship consists of two-man teams from the same NJSGA member club. Both qualifying rounds are 18-hole stroke play; the Championship proper is match play consisting of 32 teams, including the defending Champions (Ed Alden and Gregg Cartier of High Bridge Hills). The second and final qualifying round will be held on Monday, August 13 at the Westlake Golf and Country Club in Jackson.
