The two-man team of Niall Handley and Brian Komline of High Bridge Hills combined to shoot a seven-under par 64 (31-33) to claim medalist honors today in the second and final qualifying round for the 76th New Jersey State Golf Association Four Ball Championship at the par-71, 6464 yard High Mountain Golf Club in Franklin Lakes. Handley and Komline's effort led a total of 14 teams into the match play Championship proper which will be held at the Spring Brook Country Club in Morristown August 11-13.

Today's fourteen qualifying teams plus seventeen others from last week's qualifier at Trenton Country Club join defending Champions Gregg Angelillo and Michael Deo of Montclair Golf Club in competition for the Ridgewood Country Club perpetual Championship trophy.
