

107th New Jersey State Golf Association Amateur Championship
Sectional Qualifying Round – Linwood Country Club
Final Results – Monday, May 19, 2008

LINWOOD, NEW JERSEY - Under very blustery conditions, Anthony Martire of Seaview claimed medalist honors with his even-par 70 (34-36) in a sectional qualifying round for the 107th New Jersey State Golf Association Amateur Championship at the par-70 Linwood Country Club in Linwood. Martire's even-par effort led a total of seventeen qualifiers into the Championship proper which will be held June 3-5 at the Little Mill Country Club in Marlton.

Today's qualifier at Linwood is the second of three qualifiers; the first was held at Jumping Brook last Thursday, while a third is occurring simultaneously (today) at Mendham. Pairings and starting times for the Amateur Championship will be announced by the NJSGA by the end of this week.
