Brian Whitman of Knickerbocker carded a two-over par 72 (36-36) to claim medalist honors in the second of three sectional qualifying rounds for the 108th New Jersey State Golf Association Amateur Championship at the par-70, 6264 yard Lake Mohawk Golf Club in Sparta. Whitman, 27 years of age from Bloomfield, led a total of 24 qualifiers into the 72-hole stroke play Championship proper which will be held at the Fairmount Country Club June 2 – 4 in Chatham.

One additional qualifier remains scheduled for this Wednesday, May 20 at Suncagles Golf Club at Fort Monmouth. The defending NJSGA Amateur Champion is Tom Gramigna of Tavistock.
