

Deo, Stamberger Highlight Eight NJSGA Mid-Amateur Quarterfinalists

After the first two rounds of match play in the 25th New Jersey State Golf Association Mid-Amateur Championship, defending champion Michael Deo of Montclair and former Metropolitan Golf Association Amateur Champion Michael Stamberger highlight eight remaining players vying for the Gigi Carnevale Championship Trophy at the Spring Lake Golf Club in Spring Lake Heights. Deo breezed through his first two matches (5 & 4 over Michael Heller and 5 & 3 over Ivan Field), as did Stamberger (5 & 4 over Louis Giovi and 1-up over Tom Hyland) in advancing to tomorrow's quarterfinal round of eight at the sparkling par-72, 6500 yard layout.
