Peter Barron of Stone Harbor Golf Club shot a one-under par 71 (35-36) to claim medalist honors in the second of two sectional qualifying rounds for the 26th New Jersey State Golf Association Mid-Amateur Championship at the par-72, 6737 yard Pine Barrens Golf Club in Jackson, New Jersey. Under extremely wet conditions, Barron led 13 qualifiers into the match play championship which will be held at the Trump National Golf Club – Colts Neck on May 4, 5, and 6.

The NJSGA Mid-Amateur Championship consists of amateur golfers, all thirty years of age and older, from NJSGA member clubs and courses. The defending Champion is Michael Stamberger of Spring Lake Golf Club. Official starting times and the match play draw will be announced by the NJSGA later this week.
