ALLAMUCHY, NEW JERSEY – The Metedeconk National team of Andrew Piskun, William Bello, Brian Oswald, and William Kennedy combined to shoot an eleven-under par 60 (32-28) to win on a match of cards capture the 42nd New Jersey State Golf Association Best Ball of Four Championship at the par-71, 6624 yard Panther Valley Golf and Country Club in Allamuchy. Panther Valley, host of the 1994 and 2003 NJSGA Amateur Championship, was in superb condition and presented an added challenge, as the course played longer than its official yardage due to heavy rains in the days leading up to the Championship.

For the second year in a row a team from Metedeconk has won the Championship- three players (Piskun, Bello, and Oswald) were part of the 2007 Championship team. Three other teams (Charleston Springs, Forsgate, and Cottage) all finished second through fourth respectively on matches of cards.

Conducted annually in the early fall, the Best Ball of Four Championship features four-man teams from the same NJSGA member club playing in a best-ball format. The lowest net score per team counts toward the team's total.
