

Final Results: Sectional Qualifying Round
106th New Jersey State Golf Association Amateur Championship
Royce Brook Golf Club, Hillsborough, NJ – Tuesday, May 22, 2007

Co-medalists Jordan Gibbs of Bedens Brook (37-33) and Dan Marino of Due Process (33-37) each fired a two-under par 70 to lead seventeen (17) qualifiers into the 106th New Jersey State Golf Association Amateur Championship today in the third of four sectional qualifying rounds at the par-72, 6919 yard Royce Brook Golf Club in Hillsborough.

Played under perfect weather conditions on the outstanding links-style layout, the seventeen qualifiers now advance to the Championship itself at Rockaway River Country Club in Denville from June 5-7. One final qualifying round will be conducted tomorrow (May 23) at Apple Ridge Country Club in Mahwah, which will complete the Championship field.
