The Glen Ridge tandem of Ryan Harpster and Mike Sparks combined to shoot an impressive six-under par 65 (33-32) to capture medalist honors in the first of two qualifying rounds for the 77th New Jersey State Golf Association Four Ball Championship at the par-71, 6380 yard Springdale Golf Club in Princeton. Sparks and Harpster lead a field of fifteen teams into the match play championship proper which will be held at the Metedeconk National Golf Club August 10-12. The second of two qualifying rounds will be held at Suburban Golf Club in Union, this upcoming Thursday, July 30.

The Four Ball Championship features two-man teams playing in a match play, Four Ball format (better ball of two, gross scoring). The Championship team will be awarded the Ridgewood Country Club perpetual trophy. The 2008 Champions, Brian Komline and Niall Handley of High Bride Hills, will not be defending their championship.
