Eligibility Requirements - Read Carefully

Both partners **MUST** be 55 years of age (or older) as of September 28, 2010.

Both partners must be members in good standing of the
SAME NJSGA member club or course (public or private).

Both players **MUST** appear on the Official Handicap Roster at their home club/course.

TOTAL TEAM HANDICAP INDEX MUST NOT EXCEED 30.0

Handicap Index Limits effective as of 9/15/2010 Revision.

Prizes

Prizes will be awarded to the low three gross and low three net finishing teams.

Conditions

Entries are subject to approval or rejection at any time by the NJSGA Tournament Committee in its discretion. By a team's application, they agree not to protest any rejection of their entry. If a player enters a NJSGA tournament from a facility open to the general public, or from a Club Without Real Estate (CWORE), the player must be a resident of New Jersey.

Time of Starting: The Optional Condition prescribed in Appendix 1 of the USGA Rules of Golf shall be in effect.

Note: Players may be required to rent a power cart; details will be announced.

CONDITIONS

In addition to the Conditions listed on page 1 of this form, all entrants **MUST** fulfill **ALL** of the following eligibility requirements:

- Entrants must possess **UNQUESTIONABLE** Amateur Status, as per USGA Standards.
- Entrants must possess documented proof of an active and valid USGA Handicap Index through the **SAME** NJSGA member facility (public or private) at the time of entry and on the days of tournament play. Entrant **MUST** appear on the Official Handicap Roster at the club/course to which he is affiliated at the time of entry.
- When combined, the team's total Handicap Index cannot exceed 30.0 (as of the 9/15/10 handicap Revision).
- If entering from a facility open to the general public, or from a Club Without Real Estate (CWORE), entrant **MUST** be a permanent resident of the State of New Jersey.
- **NOTE:** Players are restricted to participation in NJSGA events from only **ONE** club/course during a calendar year. For example, if a player maintains memberships to two clubs/courses, the player is restricted to participating in NJSGA events from **ONE** club/course for the duration of that year. The club/course from which a player participates in his/her first tournament shall be designated as his club/course for that year.

DEFINITIONS

STARTING TIME: It is the player's sole responsibility to ascertain his starting time, verify his route to the Championship site, and be prepared to play at the starting time laid down by the Committee. The 'Official Time' is designated by the NJSGA Tournament Committee and is **NOT** open to interpretation. Please consult Section 6-3 of the USGA Rules of Golf for further important details.

WAITING LIST: A Waiting List shall be created in the event that the Championship has reached its maximum capacity of 78 teams. Teams on the waiting list will be assigned a starting time only in the event that another team in the Championship field has withdrawn. In this case, teams will be contacted by the NJSGA (note: waiting list requirements differ for other NJSGA Championships) and will be assigned the starting time of the withdrawn team. A team that does not gain entry into the Championship due to oversubscription will be refunded their entire entry fee.

All entrants, by their attempt to enter this Championship, have agreed to have read, understood, and agreed to all provisions and stipulations set forth herein. All entries are subject to the approval/rejection by the NJSGA, which reserves the right to withdraw a team's entry and amend the Championship program before or during the Championship, and to disqualify a player or team if deemed advisable. Competitors shall be considered to have subjected themselves to the authority of the NJSGA, whose decision(s) on all points shall be final. By his application, an entrant will agree not to protest any rejection of his entry. The rules of the United States Golf Association shall govern all play including any local rules as determined by the NJSGA Committee.

PLAYERS' CONDUCT

Players are reminded that they are guests and should conduct themselves appropriately at all times. The NJSGA relies upon the generosity of our host clubs, courses and volunteer officials to conduct our schedule of twenty-one State Championships. The conduct and behavior of all tournament participants is a direct reflection on the NJSGA and each player's home club. Therefore, all players are reminded of Section I and Rule 33-7 of the **RULES OF GOLF** concerning etiquette and behavior. A player's conduct interpreted or deemed to be contrary to Section I or in breach of Rule 33-7 is strictly forbidden and may result in disqualification. The scope of this rule shall extend throughout the grounds (including the clubhouse, locker room, practice area, and parking area). Further consequences, such as temporary or permanent suspension, may be imposed at the discretion of the Committee. Further, those concerned with the conduct of another player should notify the NJSGA Committee.

VERIFICATION OF HANDICAP

In addition to the conditions listed on both pages of this entry, the NJSGA reserves the right to reject a team's entry if the validity of either of their Official Handicap Indexes are in question. Before filing your entry, please ensure that both Handicap Indexes are active and **VALID** at a facility which is a member of the NJSGA. Both players **MUST** appear on the **SAME** NJSGA member facility's Official Handicap Roster in order to be eligible for this NJSGA Championship. Entries received in breach of these conditions will be rejected by the NJSGA.

REFUND POLICIES

All claims for a refund must be initiated via telephone at (908) 241-GOLF (4653).

For refunds PRIOR to the close of entries:

Team will be refunded their entry fee minus a \$50.00 service charge (regardless of reason).

For refunds AFTER the close of entries:

No refund will be issued after the close of entries **EXCEPT** in the case of unforeseen injury or illness as documented by an official physician's notice. In this case, entry fee will be refunded minus a \$50.00 service charge.

NO REFUNDS WILL BE ISSUED FOR ANY REASON AFTER THE TOURNAMENT START DATE.

NO REFUNDS WILL BE ISSUED FOR 'NO-SHOWS'; NO-SHOWS WILL BE SUSPENDED FROM NJSGA COMPETITIONS FOR ONE YEAR.

NO REFUNDS WILL BE ISSUED FOR EXTREME OR INCLEMENT WEATHER unless the tournament is postponed.
