

**Final Results - 12th New Jersey State Golf Association Senior Four Ball Championship
Edgewood Country Club, River Vale, NJ - Thursday, September 27, 2007**

The Greate Bay team of Bill Care and Douglas Fraser today captured the 12th New Jersey State Golf Association Senior Four Ball Championship at the par 72, 6491 yard Edgewood Country Club in River Vale. The better-ball of two (two man team) Championship, consisting of Senior golfers over the age of 55 was contested on the White and Red nines of the sparkling facility in northern Bergen County. Care and Fraser combined to fire a three-under par 69 (36-33) which bested the Arcola team of Larry Haggerty and Terry McBride (34-35-69) in a match of cards (low back nine). Alton Jones and J. Michael Hearn of Mendham claimed third place honors on a match of cards with their two-under par effort of 70 (37-33).

In the net division, the Duffers Golf Association (NJSGA member Club Without Real Estate) team of Mike Kozlow and Steven Grieco claimed low honors with their effort of 60 (29-31), which bested the second place Picatinny team of Robert Shipe and Roman Fedyna (33-30-63). The Mount Tabor team of Robert Estler and Doug Kehoe finished third in the net division on a match of cards with a total of 64 (33-31).
