In the third and final qualifying round for the 108th New Jersey State Golf Association Amateur Championship, Kyle Magnusson of Eagle Oaks (33-37) and Brian Leveille of New Jersey National (33-37) each fired a two-under par 70 to claim co-medalist honors at the par-72, 6358 yard Suneagles Golf Club at Fort Monmouth in Tinton Falls.

Magnusson, 44 years of age from Spring Lake and Leveille, 22 of Basking Ridge, led a total of 22 qualifiers into the Championship proper which will be held at the Fairmount Country Club in Chatham June 2-4. Defending his Championship will be Tom Gramigna of Tavistock, who hopes to retain the Edwin M. Wild Championship Trophy.
