36 Holes, Stroke Play - Gross Scoring

Wednesday, September 29
Round 1 - 18 Holes

Thursday, September 30
Round 2 - 18 Holes

Players will be flighted according to Handicap.
Entrant must be 50 (fifty) years of age as of September 29, 2010.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Entries are open to bona-fide female amateur golfers who meet ALL of the following regulations:

- a) Entrant must be 50 years of age (or older) as of September 29, 2010.
- b) Entrant MUST possess UNQUESTIONABLE Amateur Status, as per USGA Standards.
- c) Amateur MUST have a valid USGA Handicap Index of 19.4 or less at the close of entries through a NJSGA member facility (public or private) where she is a member in good standing.
- d) Amateur MUST appear on the Official Handicap Roster at the club/course where she is affiliated at the time of entry.
- e) If entering from a facility open to the general public, or from a Club Without Real Estate, she MUST be a permanent resident of New Jersey.

NOTE: Entrants must participate in NJSGA events from only ONE club/course per year. For example, if you maintain membership at two clubs/courses, you are restricted to participating as a member of only one of those clubs/courses that year. The club/course from which you enter your first NJSGA event will be designated as your club for that year.

Note: Players age 65 and over are eligible to participate in the Super-Seniors flight. Please check box below if you plan to participate in this flight in addition to your Handicap Flight.

CHAMPIONSHIP FORMAT

USGA Rules shall govern all play. Eighteen (18) holes shall be played each day (Wednesday and Thursday). The Champion will be the player with the lowest 36 hole gross score. In the event of a tie for the Championship, a three-hole aggregate playoff will be held upon the completion of play to determine a winner. If the tie persists, play will continue hole by hole until a winner is decided. All other ties will be broken according to the USGA method for matching of cards.

Handicap flights will be created and based upon each player's USGA Handicap Index as of the October 1 revision. A Super-Senior flight will also be created and will be comprised of players age 65 and over (as of 9/29/10) who elect to play in the Super-Senior flight (in addition to their respective Handicap flight).

CONDITIONS

- The Championship field will be limited to the first 96 players whose entries are received by the NJSGA prior to the close of entries. If more than 96 entries are received, a waiting list will be created according to Handicap Index (at the close of entries). In this case, the 96 players with the lowest Handicap Index will gain entry into the Championship. Also:

- ALL PLAYERS ARE REQUIRED TO USE A MOTORIZED CART.
- CADDIES ARE PROHIBITED.

- NOTICE TO ALL COMPETITORS: Should a player withdraw from the competition after Friday's pairings are complete (other than for personal injury or emergency), she shall be disallowed entry in 2010.

CONDITIONS

In addition to the Conditions listed on page 1 of this form, all entrants MUST fulfill ALL of the following eligibility requirements:

- Entrant must have reached her (50th) birthday on or before September 29, 2010.
- Entrants must possess UNQUESTIONABLE Amateur Status, as per USGA Standards.
- Entrants must possess documented proof of an active and valid USGA Handicap Index through a NJSGA member facility in good standing (public or private) at the time of entry and on the days of tournament play. Entrant MUST appear on the Official Handicap Roster at the club/course to which she is affiliated at the time of entry.
- Entrant must possess an Official Handicap Index of 19.4 or less at the Close of Entries (Thursday, September 16, 2010).
- If entering from a facility open to the general public, or from a Club Without Real Estate (CWORE), entrant MUST be a permanent resident of the State of New Jersey.
- NOTE: Players must participate in NJSGA events from only ONE club/course during a calendar year. For example, if a player maintains memberships to two clubs/courses, the player is restricted to participating in NJSGA events from ONE club/course for the duration of that year. The club/course from which a player participates in her first tournament shall be designated as her club/course for that year.

PLAYERS' CONDUCT

The NJSGA relies upon the generosity of our host clubs, courses and volunteer officials to conduct our schedule of twenty-one State Championships. The conduct and behavior of all tournament participants is a direct reflection on the NJSGA and each player's home club. Therefore, all players are reminded of Section I and Rule 33-7 of the RULES OF GOLF concerning etiquette and behavior. A player's conduct interpreted or deemed to be contrary to Section I or in breach of Rule 33-7 is strictly forbidden and may result in disqualification. The scope of this rule shall extend throughout the grounds (including the clubhouse, locker room, practice area, and parking area). Further consequences, such as temporary or permanent suspension, may be imposed at the discretion of the Committee. Players are reminded that they are guests and should conduct themselves appropriately at all times. Further, those concerned with the conduct of another player should notify the NJSGA Committee.

FINAL DECISION REGARDING THE ACCEPTANCE OF ENTRIES IS AT THE DISCRETION OF THE NJSGA. The NJSGA reserves the right to amend the Championship or withdraw an entrant's entry at any time if deemed advisable. The submission of this entry acknowledges the agreements of the entrant that she has read, understands, and agrees to all conditions and stipulations included on both pages of this form.

DEFINITIONS

STARTING TIME: It is the player's sole responsibility to ascertain her starting time, verify her route to the Championship site, and be prepared to play at the starting time laid down by the Committee. The 'Official Time' is designated by the NJSGA Tournament Committee and is NOT open to interpretation. Please consult Section 6-3 of the USGA Rules of Golf for further important details.

WAITING LIST: A Waiting List shall be created in the event that the Championship has reached its maximum capacity of 90 entrants. Players on the waiting list will be assigned a starting time only in the event that another player in the Championship field has withdrawn. In this case, players will be contacted by the NJSGA (note: waiting list requirements differ for other NJSGA Championships) and will be assigned the starting time of the withdrawn player. An entrant that does not gain entry into the Championship due to oversubscription will be refunded her entire entry fee.

VERIFICATION OF HANDICAP

In addition to the conditions listed on both pages of this entry, the NJSGA reserves the right to reject a player's entry if the validity of her Official Handicap Index is in question. Before filing your entry, please ensure that your Handicap Index is active and VALID at a facility which is a member of the NJSGA. You MUST appear on a NJSGA member facility's Official Handicap Roster in order to be eligible for NJSGA Championships. Entries received in breach of these conditions will be rejected by the NJSGA.

REFUND POLICIES

All claims for a refund must be initiated via telephone call to NJSGA at (908) 241-GOLF (4653).

For refunds PRIOR to the close of entries:

Entrant will be refunded her entry fee minus a \$50.00 service charge (regardless of reason).

For refunds AFTER the close of entries:

No refund will be issued after the close of entries EXCEPT in the case of unforeseen injury or illness as documented by an official physician's notice. In this case, entry fee will be refunded minus a \$50.00 service charge.

NO REFUNDS WILL BE ISSUED FOR ANY REASON AFTER THE TOURNAMENT START DATE.

NO REFUNDS WILL BE ISSUED FOR 'NO-SHOWS'; NO-SHOWS WILL BE SUSPENDED FROM NJSGA COMPETITIONS FOR ONE YEAR.

NO REFUNDS WILL BE ISSUED FOR EXTREME OR INCLEMENT WEATHER unless the tournament is postponed.
