WELCOME FROM TRENTON COUNTRY CLUB

Dear Senior Amateur Participants and Representatives of the NJSGA,

On behalf of the members and staff of Trenton Country Club, I would like to take this opportunity to welcome you to historic Trenton Country Club for the 2021 NJSGA Senior Amateur. Golf has been the heart of Trenton Country Club since our founding in 1897. The course at Oaklands, as Trenton Country Club was originally known, came of age during the Gilded Era of golf. Nearly 125 years later it continues to challenge and delight players of all levels. The course is a happy confluence of the inherent beauty of the Delaware River basin, rolling terrain with various natural boundaries, and the talented architects who shaped its history.

In the Spring of 1922, world-renowned golf course architect A.W. Tillinghast visited Trenton Country Club for the first time in an official capacity. Tillinghast was retained by Trenton Country Club to examine and redesign the existing 18-hole course. Tillinghast's focus was mainly on the green complexes. Even today, many of TCC's dramatic pitches, humps, and bumps are a result of Tilly's redesign. Over the years, Tillinghast would make several more visits to Trenton Country Club, including a 1924 trip to review the ongoing work to the golf course. The review must have gone well, as Trenton Country Club, among other notable clubs, was included in a brochure Tillinghast sent out in 1925 highlighting the golf course design work he had produced. In 1930, in anticipation of hosting N.J. PGA Championship the following year, the Club finished construction on Tillinghast's redesign of the golf course, leaving the finished form which we play today.

Under the direction of our Superintendent Peter Daley, and our PGA Head Professional Graham Dendler and their staffs, we are here to provide you with spectacular service in a comfortable and hospitable environment and make this year's Senior Amateur a most enjoyable experience. We are truly honored to host this year's tournament and I would like to personally congratulate the players for qualifying and wish each of you the best of luck as you compete to become the 2021 NJSGA Senior Amateur Champion.

TRENTON COUNTRY CLUB

A PREVIEW OF THE 63RD SENIOR AMATEUR CHAMPIONSHIP PRESENTED BY THE NJM INSURANCE GROUP

For the first time, Trenton Country Club will host the New Jersey State Golf Association Senior Amateur Championship, presented by the NJM Insurance Group, on Tuesday and Wednesday, September 21-22, 2021. A total of 126 golfers will compete for the Charles H. Smith Trophy in the 63rd edition of the championship which will be contested over two days and 36 holes.

Established in 1897, the private country club located in central New Jersey was originally known as the Oaklands. Just as many historic courses were originally laid out, Oaklands featured just nine holes at its inception. Not long after, a full 18-hole course was developed and completed in 1914 by head golf professional, James H. Norton. In 1922, legendary golf course architect A.W. Tillinghast was retained by Trenton Country Club to redesign the golf course. By 1930, his work was complete and the golf course remains very similar to this day.

Nearly a century has passed since Tillinghast set foot on the property, and Trenton still provides a tough test of golf. For the Senior Amateur, TCC will be playing at over 6,200 yards. The course features a versatile layout that boasts large, yet demanding greens. Fairways are lush and tight throughout areas on the course. Most notably, Tillinghast's touch lies between the fairways, greens and tall grass at Trenton.

In 2021, Trenton will be hosting its 8th NJSGA championship, having welcomed the 1927 State Amateur, 1941, 2001 and 2005 Four-Ball, 1979 and 1998 Women's State Amateur and 2011 Junior Girls' to the club.

An impressive group of players ages 55 and older visits TCC. The field is highlighted by former champions in Norman Lewis (2019), Anthony Fioretti (2018), Bill Charpek (2017, 2015), Jay Blumenfeld (2016, 2014) and Tom Dicinti (2010).

Blumenfeld, a two-time NJSGA Senior Amateur Champion, is coming off a victory earlier this season, having won the 11th NJSGA Super-Senior Championship presented by NJM Insurance on July 13, by way of a playoff at Forest Hill Field Club. Lewis, a resident of Madison and member of Morris County Golf Club is the most recent champion in the field, after winning the 2019 title at Springdale Golf Club.

Last year, Adam Kugler ran away with the trophy, shooting a two-over par 144, taking down the rest of the competitors by six strokes. Although Kugler is not in the field this year, a loaded group of golfers highlighted by five former champions will make for a battle near New Jersey's state capitol at the 63rd Senior Amateur Championship.

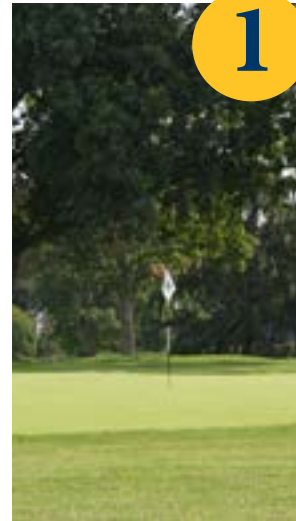

TRENTON COUNTRY CLUB | HOLE BY HOLE



1

PAR 4 - 296 YARDS

The opening hole at Trenton Country Club is a short par-4. Running down the left side of the fairway is the club's driving range. The green is flat and long, but beware of a bunker that guards the front. Just beyond No. 1 green is the green of hole No. 17.



2

PAR 4 - 433 YARDS

After opening up to a short par-4, No. 2 is a tougher test from the start as the tee shot is blind. Despite the fairway opening up in the landing zone, shorter hitters are challenged by a handful of trees that line both sides of the fairway. The straightforward approach shot heads downhill with a very wide green waiting below. Avoid a deep ball into the green since trouble awaits behind the green. The putting surface slopes right to left, but remains primarily flat.



3

PAR 3 - 195 YARDS

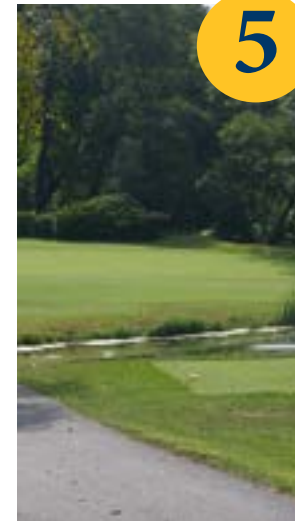
The first par-3 at Trenton is a major uphill battle, quite literally. In order to have a chance at putting for birdie or even par, hitting the tee shot dead center of the green is recommended since the green is concealed by bunkers.

PAR 4 - 315 YARDS

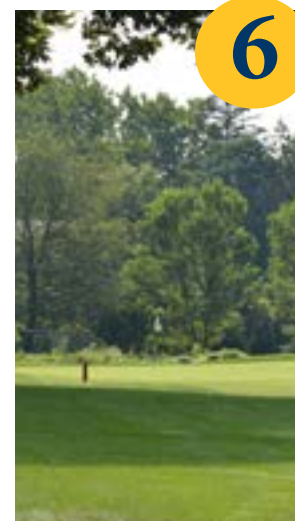
Water comes into play for the first time at Trenton on No. 4. Off the tee, a stream runs down the right side of the fairway, which slopes down left to right. A pair of bunkers on the left and right guards the green. Overall, the putting surface is flat, running front to back.



5

PAR 3 - 182 YARDS

This picturesque hole is the last par-3 on the front nine. With a water fountain straight ahead off the tee, this hole can be intimidating, however the putting surface is circular, flat and wide, limiting the chance for error on this hole.



6

PAR 4 - 315 YARDS


A well-placed tee shot is important on hole No. 6 as the fairway narrows off the tee. A grand tree sits along the left side of the fairway, which may block a player's approach into the green. A vast bunker lies on the front right side of the green. The putting surface features several swales on the front right and back middle areas.

PAR 5 - 452 YARDS


Hole No. 7 is the first of the par-5's, and it is trickier than it looks. With trees lining both sides of the fairway, placement off the tee is pivotal in order to have a chance of reaching the green in two. With a creek running through the fairway about 125 yards prior to the uphill green, this hole is truly risk or reward. A bunker guards not only the front of the green, but the right side as well. The putting surface slopes back to front and is one of the smaller greens at Trenton.

PAR 3 - 178 YARDS


The back nine opens with a par-3 that is fairly uncomplicated. A pair of broad bunkers creep in from both the front and back of the green, demanding accuracy in yardage off the tee. The putting surface slopes gently from left to right.



8

PAR 4 - 366 YARDS


No. 8 features an elevated tee with a view of a fairway guarded by two bunkers along the landing zone. This par-4 has a green that slopes uphill from front to back drastically, but does not possess any other undulations. Shot placement is important on this hole that features a turtleback green around the backside.

PAR 4 - 429 YARDS


With the combination of out of bounds and a towering tree on the right side of the hole, sticking the tee shot on the left-center of the fairway provides an ideal shot into the green. This par-4 features a wide green that slopes entirely uphill from front to back.



9

PAR 5 - 475 YARDS


No. 9 plays similar to No. 7, however out of bounds will come into play off the tee on the right side, while trees scatter the left side. The same creek which runs across No. 7 runs across the landing zone, often forcing a lay up. Although this green is very long, it's unforgiving because it is surrounded by a trio of bunkers that guard the green. The putting surface has a substantial swale in the middle and is pitched slightly uphill.

PAR 5 - 560 YARDS

This lengthy hole runs down Lower Ferry Road. About 75 yards away from the green rests a wide fairway bunker, nearly forcing competitors to layup. A narrow putting surface in the front then widens toward the back, which is guarded by a pair of bunkers.

PAR 3 - 160 YARDS


No. 13 is a short and downhill par-3. A creek runs in front of the green and out of bounds spans nearly the entire backside of the green.



16

PAR 4 - 351 YARDS


A short, but challenging hole, No. 16 tee aims players to a set of bunkers along the left side of the fairway. This green is intimidating as it is guarded by a pair of bunkers on each side. The putting surface has bowl-like features that draws golf balls into the center of the green.



14

PAR 4 - 407 YARDS


Fescue and a large waste area may be daunting immediately off the tee, but a wide-open fairway complicates matters. A precise shot into the green will be needed in order to avoid the set of bunkers on the left and right sides.



17

PAR 5 - 529 YARDS


This hole is uphill, with tall fescue running along the entire left side of the fairway. The green is flat and circular so an attempt at eagle is possible.



15

PAR 3 - 114 YARDS


The final par-3 on the course, No. 15 is the shortest hole at Trenton. One large bunker runs up to the green from the tee. The putting surface is wide in length, and sits just beside No. 16 tee.



18

PAR 4 - 392 YARDS

The finale features a minor dogleg right, with a fairway that is primarily open off the tee. A massive tree sits just off the fairway to the left. The putting surface is guarded by a pair of bunkers on each side of the small green that runs uphill from front to back.
